Capacity Building Technical Assistance Fund Request for Proposals (RFP) for Civil Society Organizations

The Canadian International Development Agency (CIDA) invites proposals from eligible civil society organizations to help advance the aims of its Capacity Building Technical Assistance Fund (CBTAF).

The purpose of CBTAF is to provide institutional support to civil society organizations that are working to promote good governance in South Africa. You may request training for your organization, funding to support a learning exchange between your organization and an organization in Canada, Africa or elsewhere in the world, or any other form of technical assistance that would help build your organization's capacity. CBTAF funding CANNOT be used to fund infrastructure, items of a capital nature, salaries, operational costs or medical expenses.

Please note that only registered civil society organizations that have been in existence for more than two years, may apply. Each organization is limited to the submission of one proposal only. ***The proposal must clearly outline what capacity will be built or improved within your organization as a result of CBTAF support.***

The proposal's budget may not exceed CAD 100 000. Projects can be anywhere from one week to one year in duration.

DEADLINE: The deadline for this RFP is 12:00 noon on Friday March 6, 2009. Four hard copies of the proposal must be received by the CIDA Program Support Unit (PSU) at 1115 Burnett Street in Hatfield, Pretoria before the deadline. **Late submissions will NOT be considered.**
